Description

Challenges to Implementation

Limited financial and human resources might deprioritize events or activities that are not business critical

Employees might not attend optional events

Informal communications opportunities are used regularly to engage employees and discuss gender equality in an informal and unintimidating way

Employees regularly attend and participate in the scheduled events or activities
